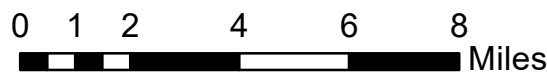
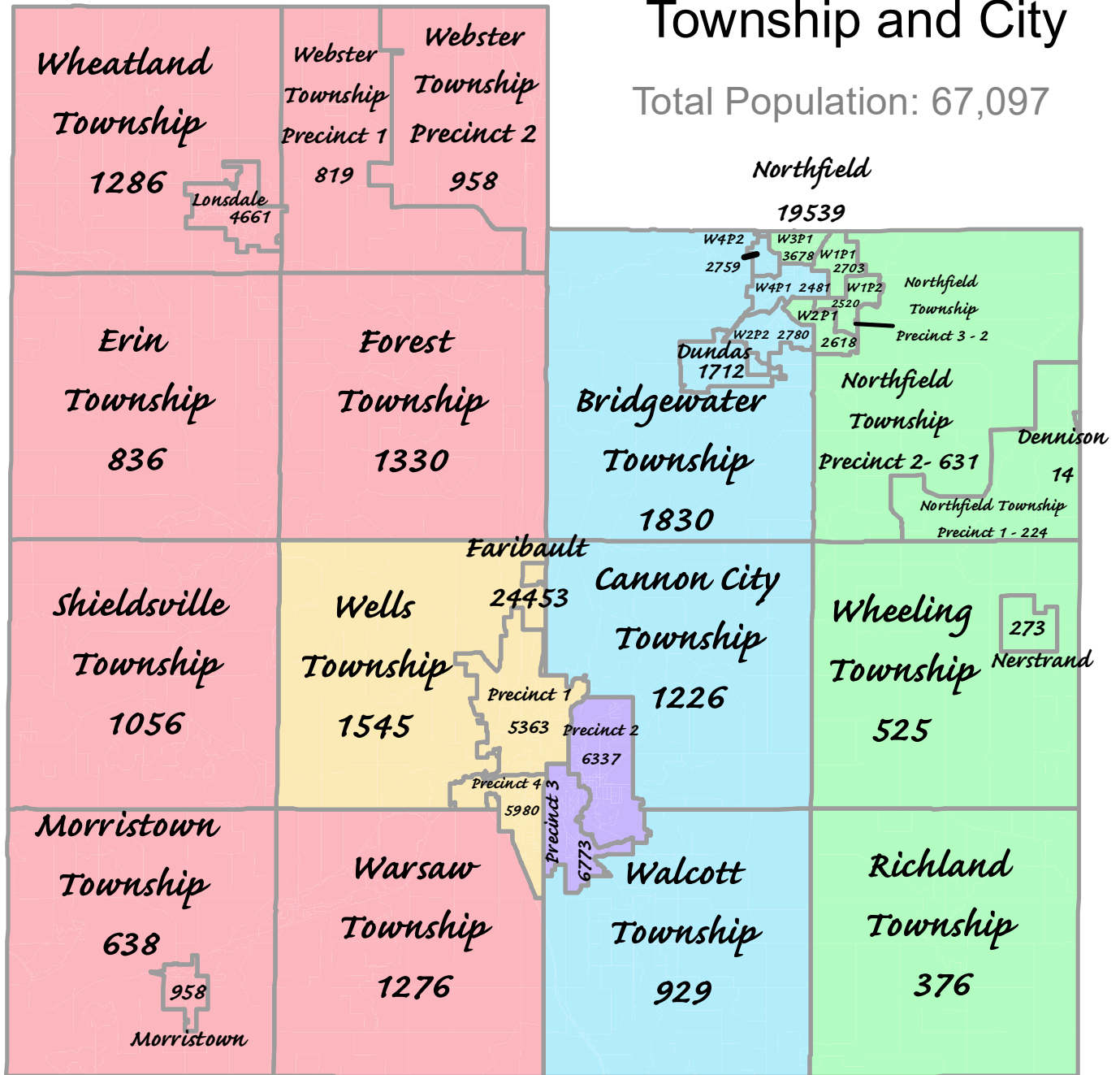

Two calculations can help answer that question: the **10% Variation Test**, and the **Majority of Least Populous Dist Have Majority of Population Test**.

Notable Changes:

Bridgwater Twp, Cannon City Twp, Dundas, Northfield W4P2 and Walcott Twp would move from CD1 to CD2 - population change of 8,456

Northfield W1P1, Northfield W1P2 and Northfield W3P1 would move from CD2 to CD1 - population change of 8,901

Overall net change is 445 (CD1 gains 445)
